# Jock The Archivist

For the past twenty-five (25) years, Jock has been a dedicated archivist and collector of historical and priceless items within the American culture. Many of these items, in the area of sports, include game worn jerseys of professional and college athletes second to none. Additionally, Jock's historical autograph and document collection includes many African American Greats, as well as autographs of all of the American Presidents and many great leaders as well that shaped the history and legacy of the United States as we know it today. Just to give you a little insight into what is recorded to be the largest collection of sports items and other artifacts in the world, listed below is just a glimpse of a few of those items by category:

- Mickey Mantle's 1956 New York Yankee road uniform worn during his Triple Crown Season.

- Satchel Paige's rare 1951 Cleveland Indians home uniform
- Stan Musial's 1948 St. Louis Cardinals silver satin uniform worn only during night games.
- Ted Williams' 1959 Boston Red Sox road uniform.
- Babe Ruth's 1933 New York Yankee home pinstripe uniform.
- Lou Gehrig's 1936 home pinstripe New York Yankee uniform.
- Sugar Ray Robinson's fight robe and trunks from the 1950's.
- Joe Lewis' boxing trunks as well as a pair of Lewis' fight gloves.

- Muhammad Ali's trunk's worn during the Mac Foster Fight in 1972.
- Sugar Ray Leonard's fight worn boxing trunks.
- One of only two pair known of First Black Heavy Champion, Jack Johnson's boxing gloves.
- Oscar Robinson's 1963 Cincinnati Royals basketball uniform #16.
- Elgin Baylor's gold game worn home Lakers uniform.
- Bill Russell's 1965 Boston Celtics Home uniform.
- Pete Maringer's home white Atlanta Hawks basketball uniform.
- Larry Bird's college worn Indiana State home white uniform.
- Magic Johnson's gold 1988 Los Angeles Lakers home game worn uniform.
- Charles Barkley's 1980 Philadelphia 76er's home uniform.
- Julius Erving's home white 1976 Philadelphia 76er's uniform.
- Jim Brown's 1960's home Cleveland Brown's football uniform.
- Gayle Sayers' late 1960's road white Chicago Bears football uniform.
- Terry Bradshaw's early 1980's home black Pittsburgh Steelers uniform.
- Jerry Rice's road white 1996 San Francisco 49er's football uniform.
- Walter Payton's 1980's home blue Chicago Bears football uniform.
- Emmitt Smith's home white Dallas Cowboys football uniform from the record breaking game.
- Joe Montana's 1980's home red San Francisco 49er's uniform.

- John Adams' autograph on a Presidential appointment document during his Presidency.

- James Madison's autograph on a Presidential appointment document during his Presidency.
- John F. Kennedy's autograph on a Presidential appointment document of a United States District Judge in the State of New York.
- Abraham Lincoln's autograph on a Presidential appointment document during his administration.
- Abraham Lincoln's autograph on a Brief signed as an Attorney in Springfield, Illinois in 1857.
- Theodore Roosevelt's autograph on White House stationery with regard to Presidential correspondence.
- Alexander Hamilton's autograph as a Lawyer in the State of New York in the late 1700's.
- John Hancock's autograph on a receipt purchasing goods and service.
- Daniel Webster's autograph on a personal piece of correspondence.
- Clarence Darrow's autograph on a letter of correspondence sent on his Chicago stationery to another individual.

- Langston Hughes' autograph on a personal letter of correspondence on his stationery.
- Alex Haley's autograph on a personal letter of correspondence on his stationery.
- Booker T. Washington's autograph on Tuskegee Institute stationery soliciting funds for the Institute.
- George Washington Carver's autograph on an 8X10 picture.
- Richard Wright's autograph on a slip of paper dated 1945.
- Martin Luther King's autograph on his first book entitled, "Stride Toward Freedom".
- W.E.B. Dubois' autograph on NAACP Crisis Magazine stationery.
- Malcolm X's autograph on the cover of Post Magazine of New York City in the 1960's.
